ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF DOG EXCREMENT

Whereas, the Village of Savoy has the authority to regulate the activity of animals within the Village, including requirements regarding dog owners to remove excrement deposited by their dogs on public property or on property of other persons; and

Whereas, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Savoy that such an ordinance be adopted requiring owners to so remove fecal matter deposited by their dogs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAVOY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

1. No owner or person in control of a dog shall permit the dog to deposit fecal matter on any public right-of-way or property, or on any private property, other than that of the owner or person in control, without providing a means of disposing of the fecal matter.
2. The owner or person in control of a dog shall promptly remove any fecal matter deposited on any such property, other than property belonging to the owner or person in control of the dog.
3. This ordinance shall not apply to support dogs, or guide dogs used by blind, visually handicapped, hearing impaired or otherwise physically disabled persons.
4. The offenses prohibited by this ordinance shall be absolute liability offenses.
5. Any owner or person in control of a dog who violates the prohibitions of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$50.00 for each offense.
